Volunteer Checklist

Before You Apply:

- 19 years old plus (22 years old if applying for Teen Program)
- Available for a one-session (4 to 7 days), overnight commitment
- Read our online FAQ for answers to our most commonly asked questions

What to Submit:

- Submit online application before February 29th, 2012 (note: online applications will be accepted until June 30th if positions aren't filled)
- Download the waivers from our website and submit to our office
- Criminal Record Search, Canadian Cancer Society policy states that criminal record checks are valid for two years from date of issue
 - New applicants: Obtain Criminal Record Search and submit the original to our office
 - Returning applicants: We will contact you to ensure that we have a valid check on file
- If you are applying for a role as a Skip or 1:1 Skip: Submit a copy of your current standard First Aid and CPR-C certification to our office by fax or e-mail before May 31st, 2012

Before You Come to Camp:

- Shortlisted Applicants: Complete an interview in March
- Shortlisted Applicants: Submit 2 recorded doses of the Measles, Mumps, and Rubella vaccination to our office by May 31st, 2012
- Complete training requirements
