



## Immunization Requirement for Volunteers

We require volunteers' immunizations be up to date for your age. This is for the protection of participants who may be immunocompromised for various reasons. Please see [www.immunizebc.ca](http://www.immunizebc.ca) if you are unsure, and for information on obtaining an immunization record. **We ask that you bring a copy of your up-to-date immunization record to Camp with you.**

Vaccinations *may* include and are age dependent:

1. Chicken Pox
2. Shingles
3. Measles
4. Mumps
5. Rubella
6. Pertussis (Whooping Cough)
7. Diptheria, Tetanus or Polio

Please contact your family doctor if you have questions about the vaccinations you require.

### **First Aid and CPR requirements:**

Camp Goodtimes requires volunteers in a caregiver role (Skips, Hosts, Volunteer Assistants and LITs) to have completed a **Standard First Aid & CPR-C** course by April 30<sup>th</sup> 2019. Standard First Aid is two-day course and includes CPR-C as part of the course. Camp Goodtimes Volunteers are required to recertify every 3 years to ensure that both their Standard First Aid and CPR-C are current.

We will consider equivalent courses in combination with CPR-C. Some examples include: OFA-1, OFA-2, OFA-3, Wilderness First Aid and First Responder. CPR-HCP is considered an equivalent to CPR-C.

If you are looking at full certification or re-certification, please consider one of the following vendors we have accepted in the past: the YWCA, TraumaTech, St. John's Ambulance or Red Cross. Camp Goodtimes volunteers may be able to access a discounted course on certain dates with TraumaTech. Contact us to find out more.
