VOLUNTEER LIFEGUARD CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

What is the certification requirement to be a lifeguard at Camp Goodtimes?

Camp Goodtimes asks for the NLS Award as a minimum qualification to volunteer as a Lifeguard.

The NLS Award is a 20 hour course that builds on the skills, knowledge and values that the Bronze Medallion and Cross awards to develop the practical skills and knowledge required by Lifeguards. It includes specialized training for a specific Lifeguarding environment through at least ONE of four options: NLS Pool, Waterpark, Waterfront, or Surf.
